## Information for Participation

### Oral Presentation

Utilizing survey results, three broad categories have been identified for clustering presentations:

Service Delivery	Collaboration	Systems and Workforce Development

Creating New Entry Point of Care	Curriculum Development	Statewide Dental Directories

The broad category for oral presentation was selected based on specific foci and the reported technical assistance the presenter offered as strength. Content of presentations are not expected to be restricted, but to fit within the framework of broad categories. The only restrictions for presentation are:

1. The presentation should focus on one unique element of the project.
2. The presentation may contain no more than 10 slides (plus one slide for introduction and one slide for listing resources).
3. The presentation should not exceed 12 minutes.

The final power point presentation should be sent to Sarah Kolo, National Maternal and Child Oral Health Resource Center (OHRC),\* via e-mailed no later than April 10, 2010, to post on the TOHSS Grantee Web page (<http://www.mchoralhealth.org/grants/TOHSS.html>). Grantees should also bring their presentation to the meeting on a thumb drive.
